1 Server hardware specifications are stated at what is deemed to be the current computing industry minimum standard for "departmental" servers. Careful consideration should be given to the value of installing hardware with additional capacity.

## **Access Requirements:**

- Provide SSL or IPSec VPN tunnel for all access to servers from remote locations
- Enable Terminal Services so the servers can be accessed remotely
- Provide 2 separate HD partitions on which VST will be installed
- Provide IIS installed on all Windows Servers
- Provide file transfer access to all servers so updates and support can be sent
- Provide a printer list to VST so printers can be installed on the server
- Must allow local admin access on all VST background users

2 Virtualized environments can be deployed in place of dedicated server installations if desired.

3 Workstation, Lap Top, and Tablet PC hardware specifications are stated at what is deemed to be the current computing industry minimum standard for new PCs. However, it may be possible to use existing hardware with less capacity.

4 For the VST Room Service Display System, the facility is responsible for acquisition of the display monitors which must be installed on the same subnet. The facility will be responsible to provide all "network drops" for all devices to support this module.

5 All printers utilized by VST must be available from the network via static IP address utilizing either an internal HP Jet Direct card or an external HP Jet Direct print server connected to all printers printing VST output. Printers to be specified at the time of purchase. Laser Printers are utilized for standard reports, menus, tray cards and BTS processes.

6 Character (Impact) printers are recommended for 1-Up label processing and interface messaging.

7 Thermal printers are utilized for room service processes. Typically, three or four receipt printers are used based on the method of operation. If the VST Room Service Display Module in use, one receipt printer is required at a minimum.

8 This device is intended for use in the tray assembly area. It is recommended for use by transport/delivery personnel for improved ergonomics. All devices are connected to the facility's WLAN. Be sure the order includes all necessary power and associated USB cords. Check with your supplier for "bundled packages" where all of the basic components are grouped at a discount.

9 Label Holders are intended for permanent placement/display of Bar Code Tags on Delivery Carts, Checkpoints, and Nursing Stations.

UPS systems and backup equipment/software with an open file agent is the responsibility of the facility. The VST System is a mission critical 24X7X365 system. To ensure successful backups of all data, open file agents on the backup software is required.
